INTENSIVE ENGLISH

Intensive English for Communication

- Seven levels from beginning to advanced
- Four or more weeks of instruction with flexible start dates
- 23 hours (or more) per week of classroom instruction
- Oral communication with native speakers

BUSINESS ENGLISH CERTIFICATES

International Business English

- Study business practices and improve business English communication
- Students participate in workshops and seminars
- Intermediate English required (students can pre-qualify with TOEFL 55 (IBT) or IELTS 5.0 or TOEIC 500)
- 23 hours (or more) per week of classroom instruction

UNIVERSITY PATHWAY

English for Academic Purposes

- For students who plan to enter a U.S. college or university
- All levels from beginning to advanced
- 12 weeks in summer, 17-18 weeks in fall or spring
- ▶ TOEFL and IELTS preparation
- Advanced students may enroll in up to two regular university courses (for an additional fee)

Pre-MBA and Pre-Master's

- Intermediate English required
- 12 weeks in summer, 17-18 weeks in fall or spring
- ▶ GMAT, GRE, TOEFL, and IELTS preparation
- Includes advising for entrance to U.S. universities

UNIVERSITY CREDIT

Programs are 17-19 weeks in fall or spring. Prequalify with TOEFL 80, IELTS 6.5, or other approved exams. Students can get an official SDSU university transcript.

TEACHER TRAINING TESL/TEFL Certificate

- No teaching experience required
- Four-week daytime sessions or 11-week evening sessions
- ▶ 130 hours of instruction
- Requires TOEFL 79, IELTS 6.5, or oral interview




UNDERGRADUATE CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

Academically eligible students can receive guaranteed admission to SDSU. Undergraduate Conditional Admission to San Diego State University (SDSU) is for qualified students, who want to apply to SDSU as a first-time freshman, but do not currently meet the SDSU English language proficiency requirements. Students can matriculate to SDSU upon completion of English language study at the ALI.

- Complete the online application at ali.sdsu.edu/apply.
- 2. Send official transcripts to the American Language Institute.
- Admissible students will be issued a letter of Conditional Admission from SDSU.
- 4. SDSU's ALI will send out I-20 and Conditional Admission letters via express mail.


COMMUNITY SERVICE
